

**Need help navigating the CACFP?

Southwestern Child Development is a Sponsoring Organization for the NC Child and Adult Care Food Program. This program is a part of the Federal USDA.

As a Sponsoring Organization, Southwestern Child Development works with Licensed Family Child Care Homes & Licensed Centers to help them receive reimbursement for approvable meals and snacks that they serve to currently enrolled children in their care.

Reimbursement is based on the following guidelines;

Provider Income

School District % of needy Families - must be above 50% to qualify

Child's Family Income

Census Data



In some cases and if income guidelines are met, family child care home providers are able to claim their own children for reimbursement.

Southwestern Child Development offers Direct Deposit for monthly reimbursement for the facilities sponsored.

There is no charge for Family Child Care homes to participate in this program.

For Child Care Centers, a nominal fee of 15% of the total reimbursement amount for the month is charged. This includes on-site technical assistance as well as phone and internet assistance. Southwestern will handle the yearly contract renewal process and provide all necessary CACFP trainings at no added cost to the child care program or home.
